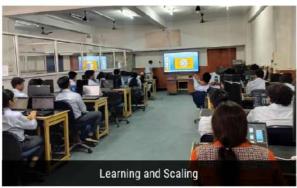

Workshop on Full Stack Web Development: Igniting Young Minds



AZARA, June 10: A 6-Days Workshop on Full Stack Web Development was conducted from June 5th to June 10th 2023 by the Department of Computer Science, Girijananda Choudhury University. Mr. Devaraj Mahanta, Research Scholar, IASST, Guwahati and Mr. Risheraj Baruah, Teaching Associate, Department of Computer Science, Guwahati University were invited as resource persons for the workshop. A total of 66 students participated in the workshop. The students actively participated in the hands-on training sessions and the assignments. The course content included basic and advanced topics like Introduction to HTML, CSS, Flexbox, Grid, Bootstrap, Web Design, JavaScript, DOM, jQuery, Node.js, Express.js, API, Github and Version Control, EJS and SQL, MongoDB, Mongoose, Deploying a Web App, Authentication and Security, React.js and Web3. It was a dynamic and an instrumental teaching medium that introduced the students to the subjects through real-time problems and hands-on training with the current technologies in the domain.
