One-day workshop on "Emergence of e-Pharmacy: Opportunities and Challenges for Pharmacists"

AZARA, June 10: A one-day workshop on the theme "Emergence of e-Pharmacy: Opportunities and Challenges for Pharmacists" was organized for in-service hospital pharmacists on 10th June, 2023 by The School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Girijananda Chowdhury University (GCU), Assam, in collaboration with Assam Pharmacy Council.

The workshop aimed to provide a platform for the pharmacists to update their knowledge and skills on the emerging trends and issues related to e-pharmacy, the online platform for delivery of medicines and other health products. The workshop was inaugurated by Mr. Jashodaranjan Das, President of SSA, GCU, who welcomed the delegates and speakers. He was followed by Prof. (Dr.) Kandarpa Das, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of GCU, who highlighted the importance and relevance of the workshop in the current scenario.

Dr. Bishnu Prasad Deka, Medical Director, Central Hospital, N.F. Railway, Maligaon, Guwahati; Prof. Biswajit Mukherjee, Professor, Department of Pharmaceutical Technology, Jadavpur University; and Mr. Hridayananda Mahanta, Retd. Two days interactive session on "Recent Advancements in Drug Discovery"

AZARA, June 06: A two days interactive session on the topic "Recent Advancements in Drug Discovery" was held at Girijananda Chowdhury University on 5th and 6th of June, 2023 for students of M. Pharm and faculty members. Prof. Samir Bhattacharya and Prof. Shelley Bhattacharya, School of Life Sciences, Dept. of Zoology, Viswa Bharti University, Santiniketan graced the platform as the keynote speakers.

DAY1: Prof. Samir Bhattacharya delivered a lecture on the topic "Excess lipid accumulation is associated with Type II diabetes (T2D) and cardiovascular problems". The lecture showered light on the recent advanced reports about the pathophysiology and factors related to onset of type II diabetes and its probable targets for treatment. Prof. Shelley Bhattacharya spoke on the topic "Stem Cells: Perspectives and challenges" highlighting the current trends of research in the field and future prospects. Individual technical sessions were followed by question answer rounds.

DAY 2: A discussion was held on the proposal for establishing Drug Discovery Centre addressing the various queries and seeking advices from the invited experts regarding the possible outcomes and challenges.
