INTRODUCTION

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 envisages a new pedagogical and curricular restructuring of the education system in India that will contribute to an equitable and sustainable society of knowledge. The policy foresees an academic environment where students acquire values, skills, and intellect to become global citizens. Therefore, educational institutions are responsible for imparting education for academic excellence and focusing on holistic and integrated learning.

The curriculum and pedagogy shall now move from traditional rote learning to a system of genuine understanding and learning how to learn. Hence, the approach should be outcome-based education (OBE), emphasizing desired learning outcomes as the central focus of the teaching and learning process. It is a student-centric teaching and learning methodology integrated into the course delivery, where student's performance is assessed based on their outcomes at various stages, from understanding concepts to creating or designing projects.

The three-day Regional Workshop in the Northeast is henceforth organized to fulfill the sole purpose of NEP 2020 and adopt the OBE pedagogy. It is aptly designed for the teachers to provide them with handson training. It shall offer a unique opportunity for senior secondary teachers to acquire new knowledge and explore deeper within to identify their own expertise in a meaningful way. Participants shall engage in various individual and group activities and practical exercises where mutual sharing and learning from one another takes place. Facilitators will initiate and involve them in collaborative projects to enhance their experience and provide engaging, enjoyable, experiential learning.
