ENTREPRENEURSHIP SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

AZARA, November 11: The MSME-Development & Facilitation Office, Ministry of MSME, Government of India, in collaboration with the Foundation for Thoughtful Reasoning (NGO), recently organized Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme (ESDP) in Salmara, Baihata Chariali, Kamrup District, Assam. The program, held from September 24 to November 5, 2024, aimed to support aspiring entrepreneurs and unemployed educated youth in the local area, empowering them to establish their own self-employment ventures.

As part of this initiative, on the concluding day of the ESDP, November 5, 2024, a key lecture was delivered by Mr. Faruk Ahmed, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Business Administration Girijananda Chowdhury University, Assam. Mr. Ahmed's session provided a comprehensive overview of the fundamentals of business accountancy, specifically focusing on the essentials of preparing balance sheets, maintaining financial records and managing cash flows skills crucial for any aspiring entrepreneur. Mr. Ahmed addressed the gathering, emphasizing the importance of financial literacy in running a successful enterprise. He highlighted how knowledge of business accountancy can empower individuals to make informed financial decisions, track the financial health of their ventures, preparation of financial statements and reporting and plan for future growth. The session stressed the importance of maintaining records of transactions, sales, purchases, and other expenses. Participants were shown how systematic record-keeping simplifies tax filing, enables better decision-making and facilitates access to loans or funding opportunities.





The lecture also covered the preparation profit and loss statements and cash flow statements, helping participants comprehend the importance of regular financial reporting for tracking profitability and managing expenses. He further guided the participants by way of giving the preliminary knowledge in preparing balance sheets, explaining them to list assets, liabilities, and equity accurately. This skill is vital for understanding the financial health of a business at any given point in time. With the skills gained through this program, participants are poised to bring positive change to their communities, establishing small businesses that contribute to local economic growth. This ESDP has thus marked a promising milestone for Assam's aspiring entrepreneurs, setting them on the path to sustainable and successful self-employment.
