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ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

(From 17th November, 2022 to 31st March 2024)

The Girijananda Chowdhury University, Assam was one of the first few universities established according to the mission of the National Education Policy (NEP)-2020. It was established on 17th October, 2022 by Act No. XLVII of 2022 of the Assam Legislative Assembly as a State Private University upgrading three premier institutes of higher learning viz. Girijananda Institute of Management and Technology (GIMT), Guwahati, Girijananda Institute of Pharmaceutical Science (GIPS), Guwahati and, Girijananda Institute of Pharmaceutical Science (GIPS), Tezpur. The GIMT Azara, which was established in 2006, has the reputation of being the first private engineering institute in Assam. Moreover, GIPS, which was instituted in 2007 as the second private pharmaceutical institute in Northeast India, has forged a powerful impact in the field of pharmaceutical education in Assam, and in India, at large. These institutes were imparting professional higher education in Engineering, Management and Pharmacy in a spirit of philanthropy and social commitment since 2006 and were the first of its kind in the entire North East.

Girijananda Chowdhury University shall create a culture of education that will provide students a transformative experience – intellectual, ethical, cultural and social. We envision a society where our students shall contribute with unparalleled professionalism, competence and integrity while upholding the basic human values of liberty, justice and equality.
