The main campus of the Girijananda Chowdhury University (GCU) is located at Azara, Guwahati on the the Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport road and just five km away from the airport. The campus is also conveniently located just 10 km from the Kamakhya Railway Station and 16 kms from Inter State Bus Terminal (ISBT). It is on the bank of the famous Deepor Beel, a natural water body which is a heaven for birdwatchers and aquaphile. The majestic Khasi & Jaintia hills stand on the southern side of the "Beel", providing a green picturesque view that is soothing to the eye.

The constituent campus of the GCU is at Tezpur, which presently accommodates the Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Pharmaceutical Science, established in 2020. This is the first pharmacy institute in the state of Assam established under PPP (Public Private Partnership) model. Director of Technical education, Govt. of Assam. GIPS, Guwahati hold a rank among pharmacy institutes in India in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), MHRD, Govt. of India from 2017. GIPS, Guwahati achieved gold rating by AICTE-CII survey of Industry-linked technical institutes, 2019.
